Derek Tidball served as pastor of two Baptist churches, became Head of the Mission

Department of the Baptist Union, then a tutor at the London School of Theology becoming the principal from 1995-2007. He was President of the Baptist Union in 1990-1991 and became Vice-President of the Evangelical Alliance in 1995. Derek is the author of over 20 books and has delivered the Bible Readings at Spring Harvest and Keswick plus other Bible Conventions internationally. Now he divides his time between writing, speaking, supervising postgraduate students, examining and advising Bible and theological colleges on their work. He is married to Dianne, Regional Minister for the East Midlands Baptist Association.



Andy Twilley is a Baptist minister who was in local church leader-

ship for 13 years and is now Director of Christian Life and Ministry with the Nationwide Christian Trust.

Andy's work includes providing training for local churches, the production of new resources, developing strategic links with other organizations, as well as overseeing all aspects of the Pastoral work carried out at Mulberry House. He is married to Louise, has three sons plus three step sons.



Andy Frost is a surf-obsessed, movie loving, bible reading, globe

trotting Londoner. He is the Director of SJI and is passionate about seeing how the Church can re-connect with society and culture. He loves dreaming big and pioneering new initiatives. He has written God on the Road and has co-authored books including The Church has Left Freestyle.

Andy has co-planted Be Church and is married to Jo. He is also a trustee for Christian Surfers UK.



Dot Tyler is a passionate, young evangelist who loves to laugh. She is

dedicated to equipping young people to serve local church and to building up a generation of young evangelists everywhere.

She currently heads up Emerging Culture, which is an organisation committed to mobilising teens, twenties and students to be passionate about mission.

Dot is being trained at the moment by the Billy Graham Evangelist Institute.



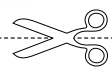
Rob Cotton is Bible Society's Senior Campaign Manager. Rob helped run media campaigns in

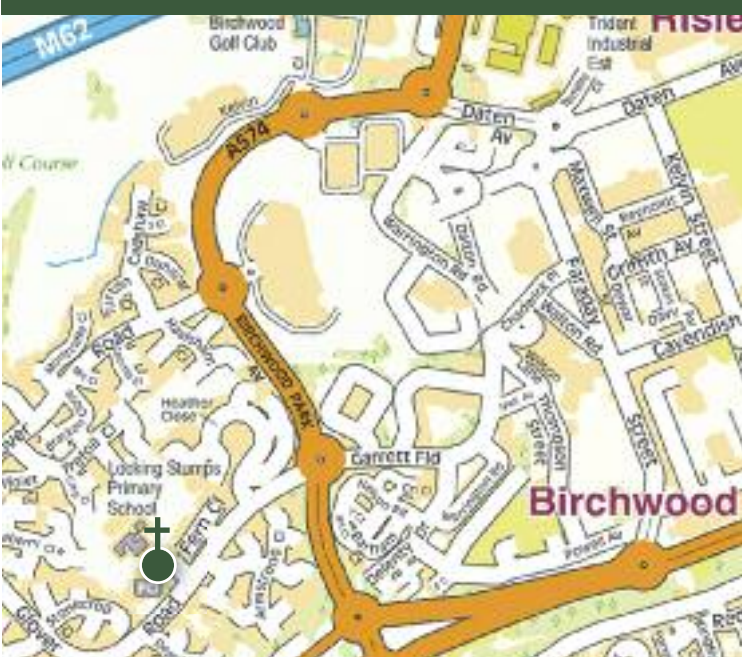
Previously, Rob has served as a Methodist Minister in Preston and in Arnold, Nottingham.

Seminar B: Dot Tyler

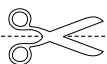
