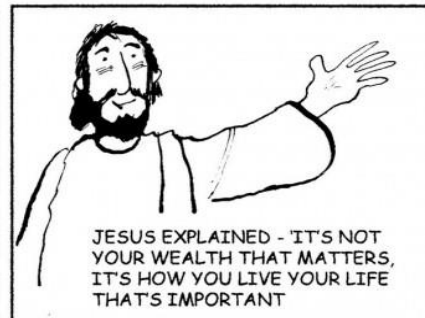

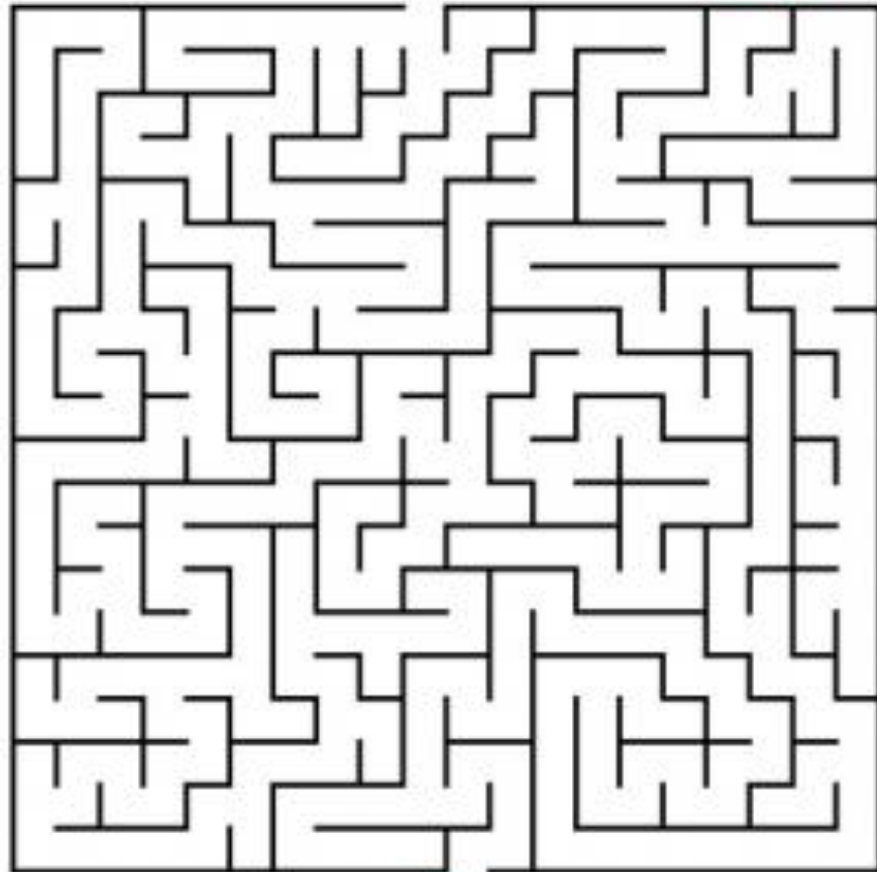

Help the farmer find the way through the maze to the tractor.



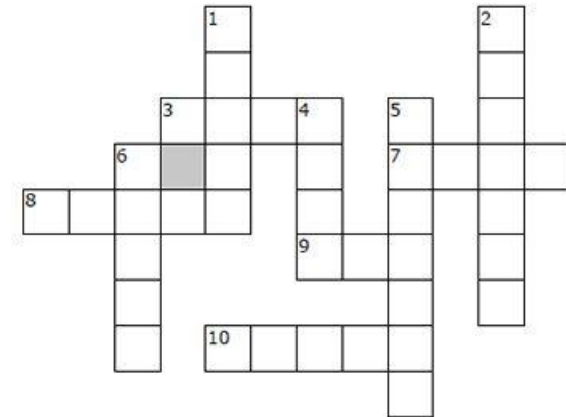
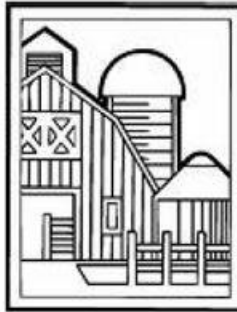
