A message from Ron. This is a request for help in distributing prayer request cards around Locking Stumps. The idea is to distribute cards to every home in Locking Stumps, one area at a time, hopefully weekly. There's actually 24 areas on our regular distribution list so we could try to deliver cards twice a year to each home.
