LATER DATES

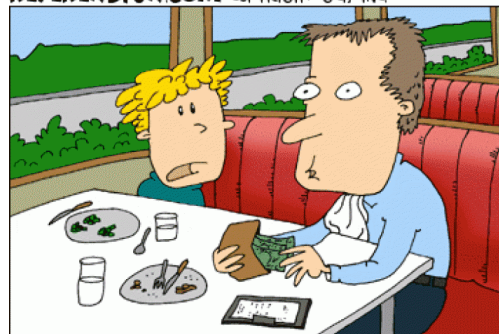
