Pray for those you live with. Ask God to look after them.

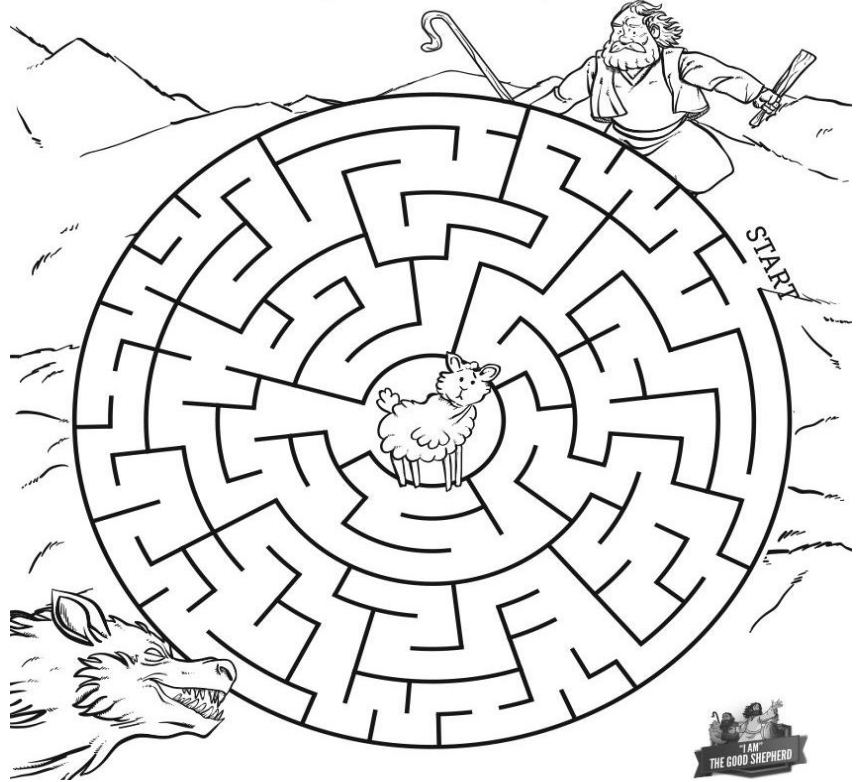

Protect the sheep before the enemy reaches them.

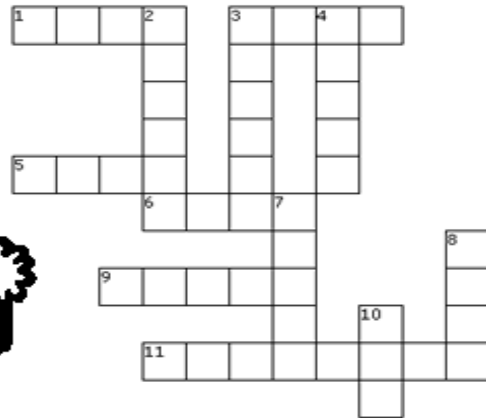
