Journeying With Jesus - Summer Challenge 2023

Godly character. In tough times and easy ones, with difficult people and delightful people, remember the fruit of the Spirit – **love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.** Pray that you grow to be more like Christ.



Good works. What we do and how we do it! Doing good work that serves others and helps them and creation. Trying to do your tasks consciously for the Lord, in the Spirit and to his glory. Seeking God's wisdom, his strength, and his touch. Ask for the Holy Spirits transforming help to make your best really shine.



Grace and love. Practical care and kindness for those who need it. The way we respond in everyday situations. Especially the difficult ones! How do we engage with each person we meet? Consider the other person's long-term interests. Not just our own.



Spark Change. Begin with a few people and a few small actions. What things bother you? What are the values that underpin them? What could be done differently that would make it a better place for people to flourish? Pray for Guidance to make it more like God's will, here on earth.



Speak Out for Truth & Justice. There are times when being a disciple means **speaking against** things that are unfair, unhealthy, or untruthful. Or maybe **speaking for** things that are true and just and good. It takes courage, wisdom & prayer.



Share the Good News. Be ready 'to give a reason for the hope that is in you' (1 Peter 3:15). Ask for prayer and support. Rest in God, trust in his timing. Build trust and relationships, care for people, and share what Jesus has done in your life and what he offers to everyone.
